As a general guideline, a \$2,500 prize at 160 yards (men) and 150 yards (women) for a full field of 144 golfers would carry an approximate cost of \$150 per insured hole. Please note this is an estimate only — final pricing will be confirmed at the time of your quote, as rates and availability are subject to change.

For prizes exceeding \$5,000, spotters are required on the designated hole.



POLICIES & REGULATIONS

Deposit

- All bookings are considered tentative until a deposit is received.
- Deposits are non-refundable.

Cancellations

- Cancellations made within 14 business days of the event will be charged full tournament fees.
- Tournaments proceed rain or shine; cancellations are permitted only if EGMGCC deems the course unplayable.
- In the event of a weather-related or unforeseeable cancellation, please note the Food & Beverage Department requires 60 minutes to prepare meals once confirmed.

Payment

- A credit card is required on file to cover additional expenses or damages, even if deposits are paid by cheque, debit, or cash.
- An invoice will be emailed on or shortly after the tournament date. Payment is due within 14 days of receipt.
- Outstanding balances beyond 30 days will be automatically charged to the credit card on file.

Gratuities

- A 15% gratuity will be added to the total tournament invoice.
- Gratuities are a taxable line item.

Initial

Liquor Policy

- The EGMGCC liquor policy follows all Alberta Gaming, Liquor and Cannabis (AGLC) regulations.
- All alcohol must be purchased through EGMGCC.
 Outside alcohol is strictly prohibited and will be confiscated.
- Violation of this policy may result in revoked playing privileges. Tournament organizers are asked to help enforce this rule, as damages often occur due to overconsumption of outside alcohol.
- Tournaments hosting a liquor hole must purchase alcohol from EGMGCC.
 - Hard liquor is sold by the bottle.
 - Pricing guideline: \$5.00 per beer, cooler, or ounce (subject to change).
 - Special requests can be accommodated with notice
- Drink tickets are available and will be charged based on the number distributed.
- AGLC regulations allow one alcohol hole per nine holes.
- **14 days' notice** is required for all liquor hole purchases.

Food and Beverage

- All menu prices are subject to change and will be confirmed no later than 60 days prior to the event.
- In compliance with provincial health regulations, all food must be prepared on club premises.
- **No leftover food** may be removed from the premises.

POLICIES & REGULATIONS

Speed of Play

- Slow play is not acceptable; all golfers are expected to maintain pace with the group ahead.
- Course Marshals will monitor pace of play.
 Groups falling behind may be asked to pick up their balls and move forward to maintain flow.
- A 5-hour round is expected. After 5½ hours, play must conclude regardless of hole completion.
- Harassment of marshaling staff will not be tolerated. Offending groups will be removed from the course.

Power Carts

- The EGMGCC maintains a fleet of 72 power carts.
 - If your event requires more than 72 carts (including those for volunteers, photographers, or organizers), please provide at least 60 days' notice.
- For a full 144-player event, two carts are allocated for tournament errands.
 - For every two players fewer than 144, one additional cart becomes available for organizer use.
- For events requiring additional rental carts, the number of players confirmed 30 days prior will determine the number of billed rentals.
- No stickers, labels, or adhesives are permitted on carts. A \$300 cleaning/damage fee per cart will apply for any violations.

Course Setup

- Setup details must be provided at least
 10 days in advance and must include:
 - Prize holes, drink holes, and food hole locations
 - Any tables, chairs, or special setups requested
- Towels, umbrellas, and coolers are not provided — sponsors and volunteers should come prepared.
